We become part of a parish through baptism, and through the living out of Baptism. Every person works for the parish, and uses their talents for the parish for every person have different talents needed in the parish. One is not a parishioner simply by living in a geographical area. This is simply a myth. We are very fortunate here in Pobal Parish for we have a community with Jesus at the centre, and we have people with Jesus at the centre. Others go to help people through music, golf, teaching in schools, and by bringing the joy of good example where ever they go.
